Mayor Witt called the meeting to order. Schmidt made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meetings. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor with Clement abstaining. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to approve the purchase orders through consent agenda. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Treasurer Report and Budget Reports were also reviewed. There was no Public Comments.

Roybal told Council there was 5,509,000 gallons of water pumped with 4 water meters changed out. The sewer pumped 3,381,183 gallons into the lagoons with 1 issue sewer reported. Eight gas leaks (Class 3 – very small) has been fixed. Gas odor call outs were a total of 4 for the month. One gas meter was changed out that quit working. She will visit with Daryl from the County about Chip Sealing this year. The County has also given caleche and red dirt to use in the alleys. Mechanical disfunction with Trash Truck mast that caused an accident with an electric pole, damages have been taken care of. New sign has been placed at the front gate at the landfill. Three grave openings were for February and total work orders were 54. New fuel pump installed on 2020 Chevy Silverado 2500 by C&R Tire.

The Librarian Report was reviewed. Hedrick reported having issues with the alternator on the Explorer.

Schmidt made a motion to approve Ordinance 2025-1 yearly deposit of funds for the Volunteer Fire Department memberships. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to approve clean up week for April 22, 2025 through April 26, 2025. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to take no action as there is no money in the budget for a Police Chevy Tahoe and requested that the Police Department look into grants and other avenues to help with the cost of a new vehicle. The new vehicle will have to be put out for bid also. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

There was no new business, so Schmidt made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
