Mayor Witt called the meeting to order. Schmidt made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meetings. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Hofferber made a motion to approve the purchase orders through consent agenda. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Treasurer Report and Budget Reports were also reviewed. There was no Public Comments.

Roybal told Council there was 5,152,000 gallons of water from wells pumped and 3,606,733 gallons pumped for the sewer for January. There are water leaks on Jackson St and Lincoln Street. There are 5 water meters and 2 gas meters on the not working list. There has been some driveshaft repair on the sewer sprinkler. The total work orders for January 2025 was 65.

Garcia reported no building permits. Hedrick and Garcia are looking to replace the K9 unit due to issues going on with the current unit. They will put some numbers together and get back with Council.

Carina Roybal reported the Library has received State Aid in the amount of \$3028.00. The Library Board met on January 23, 2025.

Schmidt made a motion to change the landfill fees. Instead \$7.50 for white items, it will be \$5.00 each moving forward. Also, concrete and construction/remodeling materials will no longer be accepted. The fees for non-residents are double the resident rate. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to change the Gas Utility Deposit Fee from \$125.00 to \$150.00 for new accounts. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to change the Water Utility Deposit Fee from \$75.00 to \$100.00 for new accounts. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to change the Credit Card Convenience Fee from 3% to 3.5%. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

There was no new business, so Hofferber made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
